Dear Counsel:

The parties were before the Court on May 15, 2023, for a hearing regarding Plaintiff's Motion for Class Notice and Defendants' objections thereto. Jon Egan appeared for Plaintiffs and Ian Maher and Heather St. Clair appeared for Defendants. All appeared remotely.

After reviewing the pleadings and oral arguments, the Court makes the following rulings:

1. Granting Plaintiffs' request to name SSI as class administrator.
2. Denying Plaintiffs' request for putative class members' social security numbers and DOBs, and requiring Defendants produce a full list of names and last known addresses for putative class members within 14 days of this order.
3. Approving as to form and content Plaintiffs' Exhibit A (not including the opt out form proposed by Defendants) and approving first class mailing method to putative

class members as it meets the requirements of ORCP 32 and due process and as the best notice practicable under the circumstances and is due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.

4. Authorizing a 45 day opt out option for putative class members beginning on the date notices are mailed.
5. Plaintiffs will establish and maintain a website for potential class members that explains the litigation and requirements of the members if they wish to opt out. It will be separate and distinct from the federal litigation website. The parties will confer to determine if they generally agree on the content for the website and seek the Court's input if necessary.

Plaintiffs will prepare the form of order from this hearing and advise the Court if there are outstanding unresolved issues about the Notice.
